

AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE FACULTY OF CANON LAW OF
THE PONTIFICAL UNIVERSITY OF ST. THOMAS AQUINAS IN ROME
AND
INTERNATIONAL INSTITUTE OF THEOLOGICAL AND TRIBUNAL
STUDIES
IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF LOS ANGELES

1. **Parties:** This Agreement is entered into between the Faculty of Canon Law of the Pontifical University of St. Thomas Aquinas in Rome (“the Angelicum”) and the International Institute of Tribunal Studies in the Archdiocese of Los Angeles (“IITTS”) (Angelicum and IITTS jointly, the “Parties”). IITTS is an entity under the authority and within the jurisdiction of the Roman Catholic Archbishop of Los Angeles, a corporation sole.
2. **Purpose:** The Parties intend to collaborate in the education and formation of those men and women who are entering into administrative and judicial ministries in the Roman Catholic Church (the “Church”), and those students who wish to familiarize themselves with one or more aspects of the Canon Law of the Church, by offering accredited courses in Los Angeles, California (the “Summer Semester”). The Summer Semester will enable those students who are enrolled in the Angelicum or other similar institutions of higher learning to complete required coursework while residing on campus at the site of instruction, which will be the Immaculate Heart Retreat House in Los Angeles, California, and will offer those students who are not engaged in a formal course of studies the opportunity to benefit from sharing in the Parties’ educational collaboration.
3. **Program:** The curriculum of the Summer Semester will be determined on a collaborative basis by the Parties, with the goal of providing in Los Angeles at least one full academic year of the three-year program in Canon Law studies at the Angelicum. The Summer Semester will be conducted from June 13, 2011, through August 26, 2011. The second Summer Semester’s schedule will be determined by mutual agreement for the dates June 11, 2012 through August 24, 2012 .
4. **Tuition and Fees:** Tuition fees with full room and board (the “Enrollment Fees”) shall be fourteen thousand dollars (\$14,000) per student who enrolls in and completes the full Summer Semester for credit at the Angelicum (the “Ordinary Students”). All Enrollment Fees, Tuition Fees and Room and Board Fees will be invoiced, collected and accounted by IITTS. At the conclusion of each Summer Semester, IITTS shall remit to the Angelicum the Tuition and annual registration

fees paid by the Ordinary and Part-time for credit Students who are enrolled in the Summer Semester as follows¹:

Full Summer Semester Tuition Fees for Ordinary Students: €890.00

Tuition Fees for Part-time and Part-time Non-Credit Students: €50.00 per credit for each course

Annual registration Fees for Part-time and Part-time Non-credit Students: €65.00


The Angelicum shall have the right to review the financial records maintained by IITTS for the Summer Semester program, which will be provided to the Angelicum upon reasonable request. Each individual student shall be responsible for payment directly to the Angelicum of any fees associated with any request for an official transcript from the Angelicum for courses taken for credit.

5. **Faculty:** Faculty for the Summer Semester will be associated with the Angelicum or IITTS, as the curriculum requires and shall be approved by the Angelicum. Faculty from other institutions may be retained as agreed between the Parties. Faculty who are not American citizens or in possession of the documentation required to work in the United States shall be assisted by IITTS in obtaining the requisite visas and/or permissions. Faculty shall receive an honorarium of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) per course. Compensation shall be paid in accordance with the employment and immigration laws of the United States and/or any non-United States country where the member of the Faculty resides. Faculty who are clergy shall obtain faculties in accordance with the requirements of the Archbishop of Los Angeles.
6. **Travel Arrangements and Housing:** IITTS shall make arrangements for booking and shall pay for any travel arrangements necessary for Faculty who are not residents of Los Angeles, California. All airplane flights shall be booked at the most economical rates and shall include travel insurance. IITTS shall make arrangements and pay for housing for Faculty who shall be required to reside on campus during their teaching duties for the Summer Semester.
7. **Insurance:** IITTS shall provide such health, accident and/or disability insurance for Faculty as is required under the laws of the United States and the State of California while the Faculty carry out their teaching duties in the Summer Semester.
8. **Jurisdiction:** except where Canon Law is specifically referenced, this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California, without regard to its principles of conflict of laws.

¹ Fees for the second semester shall be determined by the Parties at the later date.

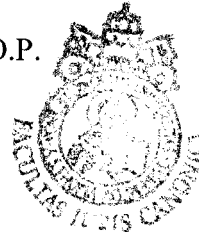
9. **Miscellaneous:** This Agreement may not be modified except in a writing signed by both Parties. This Agreement shall be binding on the Parties and shall inure to the benefit of their respective successors and assigns. This Agreement contains the entire agreement of the Parties and supersedes all prior agreements, understandings, or promises. It is an integrated Agreement. This Agreement may be signed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original and all of which together shall constitute a single instrument.
10. **Authorized Signers:** The Angelicum and IITTS represent that the persons signing below are authorized to enter into this Agreement on behalf of their respective parties.
